ORIENTATION FAQs

1. Am I required to complete the online orientation?

All international students who confirm their commitment to enrollment with SFCC, either from overseas or in-person in Spokane, will be invited and required to complete the online orientation.

2. When and how will I receive an invitation to the online orientation?

If you plan to start summer quarter online from your home country, you will receive an invitation as soon as you inform Global Education your plan.

If you plan to start summer quarter in-person, either because you already have a visa or you'd like to try to apply for an F-1 visa, you will receive an invitation upon visa approval/confirmation.

All invitations will be sent to the personal email that the students provided us on the Admissions Application form.

3. Will I attend the in-person orientation?

If you plan to start summer quarter online from your home country, you will participate in the in-person fall 2021 orientation after arrival.

If you are already in the United States or have a visa to enter the U.S. for summer, you will participate in both the online and in-person orientation for summer.

4. How much will my summer 2021 tuition be?

Tuition amount varies depending on how many classes/credits a student enrolls in for the term. The estimate for a full-time enrollment varies between the estimate of \$3,500 - \$4,500 USD. The exact total amount of tuition will appear on your online student account after you enroll in classes.
