## Multiple Start Guideline

### 2-Year AAS Degree / 4-Quarter Certificate Fall/Winter/Spring Quarter Start

This degree program is set up to allow students to enter the program in Fall, Winter or Spring quarters<sup>1</sup>. As each session starts, the students will take introductory core Math and CAD/Graphics classes along with the first-year program courses scheduled for that quarter. By completing any three quarters in a row the student will have successfully completed the first year of the program. They can then enter second year directly in the following quarter with scheduled classes.

#### Benefits:

- Students may start into our program as soon as they are eligible<sup>2</sup>.
- Students will finish their degree in six quarters and be able to pursue jobs at different times of the year instead of all in the spring quarter.
- This will make it easier for a student to make up or retake some of the courses in subsequent quarters.
